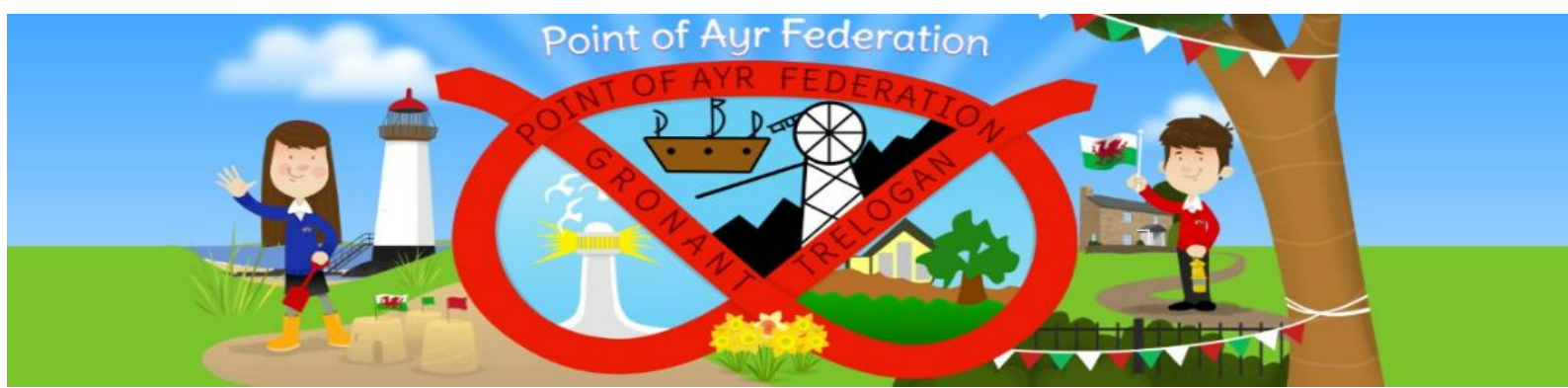




Cylchlythyr Point of Ayr Federation Newsletter - May/Mai 2025

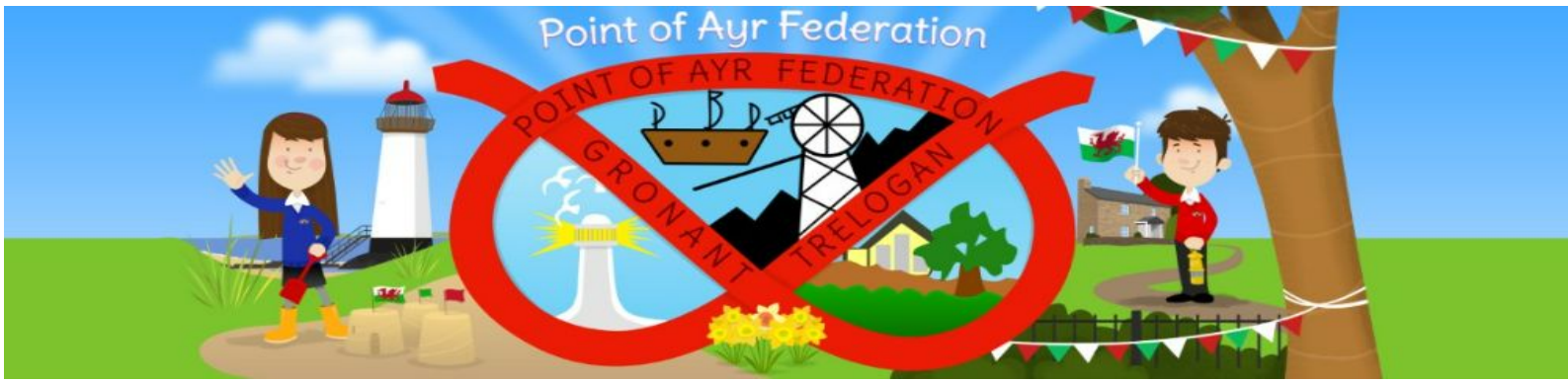

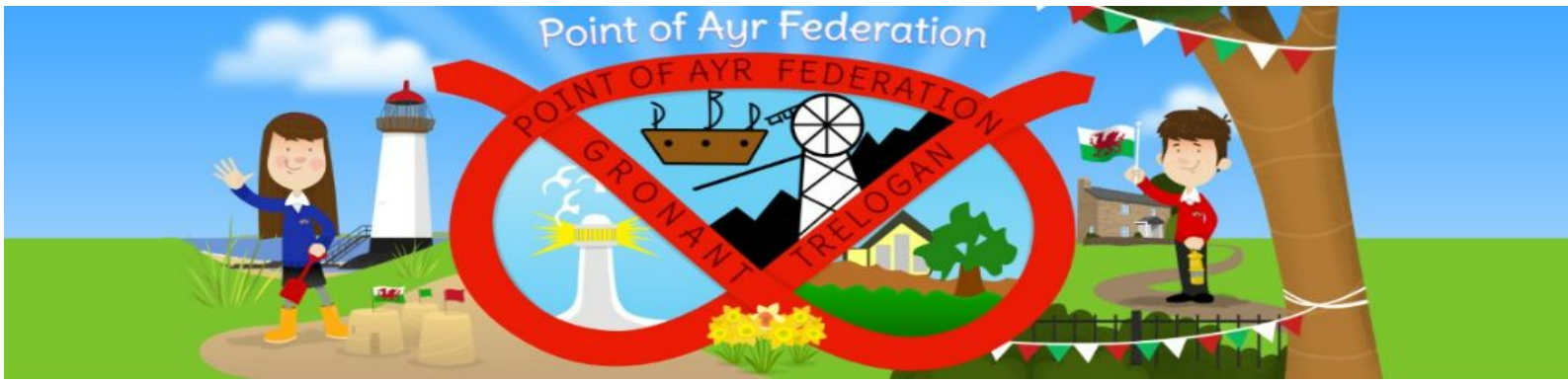

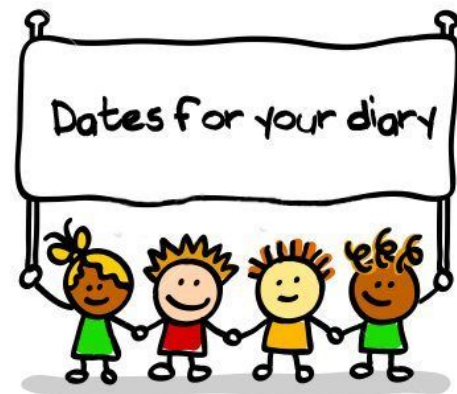
