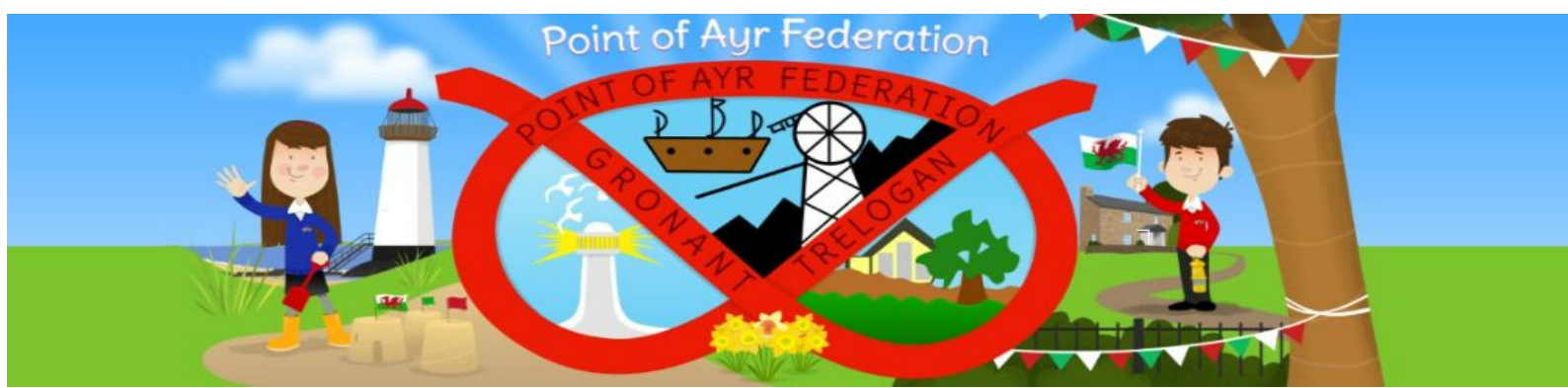




Cylchlythyr Point of Ayr Federation Newsletter - April/Ebrill 2025

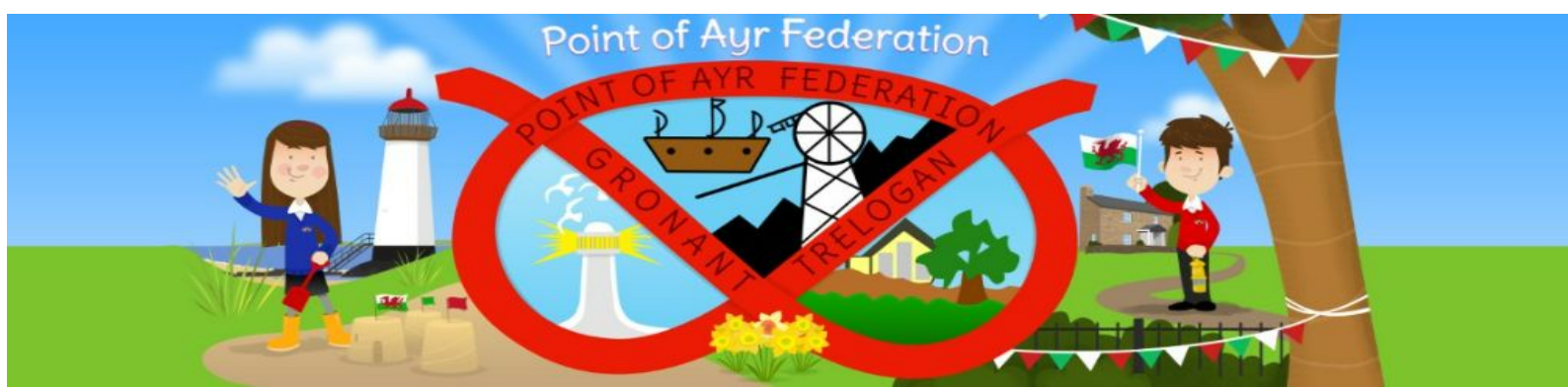


Trip Ysgol - Dosbarth Mesen and Twyni

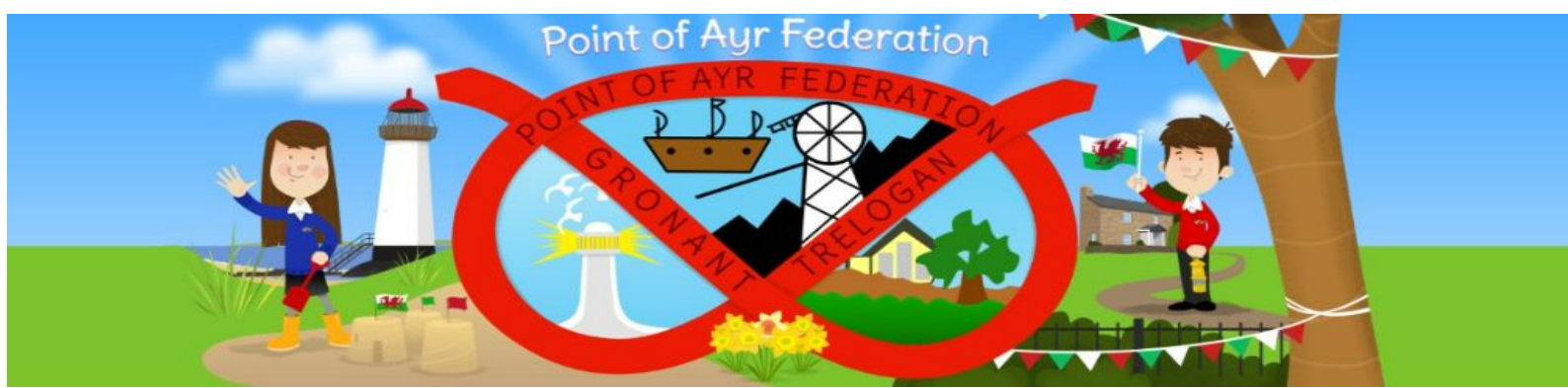
Llongyfarchiadau / Congratulations

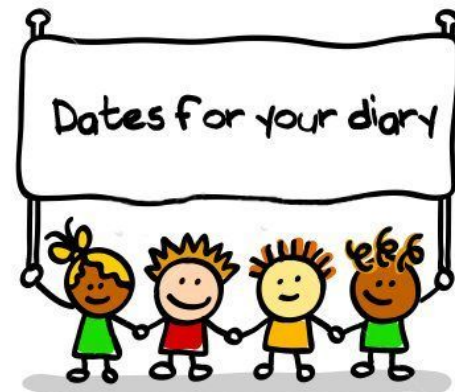
